Botanical Description:

Perennial, erect herb arises from a woody base, simple or branched, climbing, stem terete, leaves alternate, elliptic-lanceolate, white hairs on both sides, branches alternate and rarely opposite, inflorescence is white sessile, flowers are small, creamish-white and occur in a compact spike, forms a paniculate inflorescence suppressed by upper leaves, fruit is a capsule, and seeds are smooth, brown-black and shining.

Flowering/ Fruiting: September-January.

Part Used: Leaves and flowers.

Cultivation: Wild Plant.
