Perennial, multi-branched tree, whole plant is covered with white hairs, juicy milk in whole plant, stem is soft and grey, leaves fleshy, wide and heart-shaped, small petiole, flowers in clusters and white in colour, fruits oval and long, seeds small and brownish, released in the air by bursting.

Flowering/ Fruiting: Mainly November - January, generally throughout the year. Part Used: Leaves, latex, flower, leaves, latex and roots.

Cultivation: Wild
