Evergreen bushy shrub, shrub is erect, thorny, and woody, branches are forked, bark green to brown, leaves smooth, waxy, glossy, green ovate to elliptical, margin entire, flowers are sessile, white with five petals, born as solitary or in clusters, fragrant, fruit small, edible, sour in taste, purple when unripe, and turn dark blue when ripened. Seed single, brown.

Flowering/ Fruiting: October - November/December - March.

Part Used: Stem, leaves and roots.

Cultivation: Wild.
