Botanical Description:

Deciduous vine, climbing woody shrub; bark is corky and toothed; leaves are simple, oval to elliptical, long petiolate, green, smooth, leathery; base is round; flowers are pale yellow and greenish white; they occur in terminal panicles; fruit is a globose capsule, three-celled, yellow-coloured; on maturity, dark orange; seeds are three and reddish.

Flowering/ Fruiting: February-May.

Part Used: Root, leaves, seeds.

Cultivation: Wild. Longitude: 76°30'29"E. Latitude: 31°19'49"N.

Altitude: 658m.




Fig. 4.27 Economic potential of *Celastrus paniculatus* in comparison to conventional crops
