Family: Asteraceae.

Botanical Description:

Small, prostrate herb, grow in damp places, stem slender, leaves simple and alternate, may be lobed, blunt, toothed, obovate, margin toothed, one leaf per node, leaf edge lobed, flower disc shaped, stalkless, bisexual flower, bracts and hairy in nature, achenes obovate and long, brown.

Flowering/ Fruiting: December-January.

Part Used: Herb, seed.

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°24'49" E.

Latitude: 31°44'22"N.

Altitude: 560m

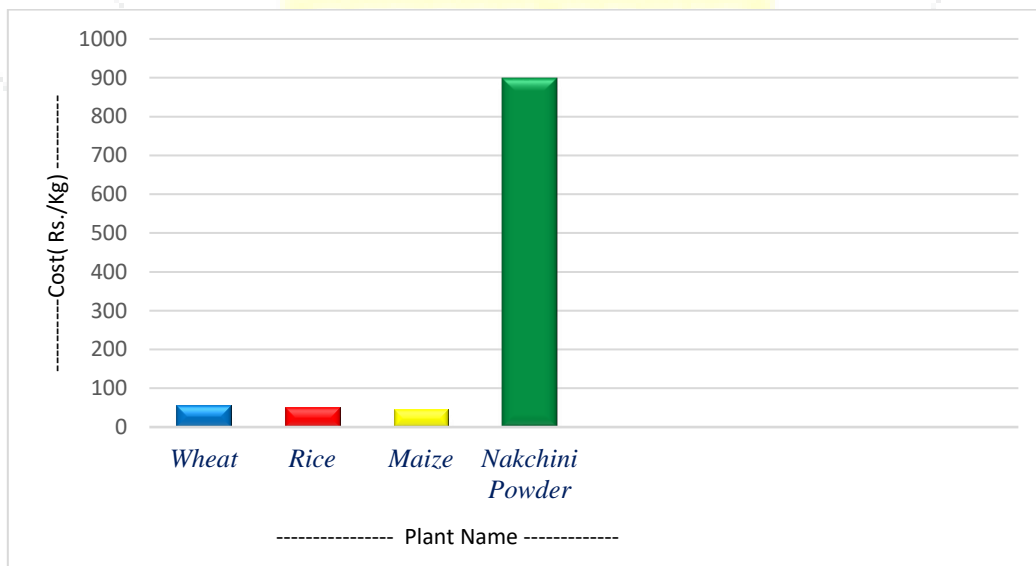


Fig. 4.29 Economic potential of *Centipeda minima* in comparison to conventional crops
