**Common/Local Name (s):** Tejhatta, Tamal-Patra, Patraj, Indian Cinnamon, Indian bark.

**Family:** Lauraceae

**Botanical Description:**

A medium-sized, evergreen tree's bark is brown with a good smell. Leaves are thick, petiolated, opposite, long, elliptical to oblong, leathery, shiny, three-veined, aromatic; flowers are small, greenish-yellow, occur in clusters, and have a strong odour; fruit is round, single-seeded, and black.

**Flowering/ Fruiting:** March – May/June - October

**Part Used:** Bark, leaves

**Cultivation:** Wild.

**Longitude:** 76°38'03"E.

**Latitude:** 31°31'15"N.

**Altitude:** 811m.

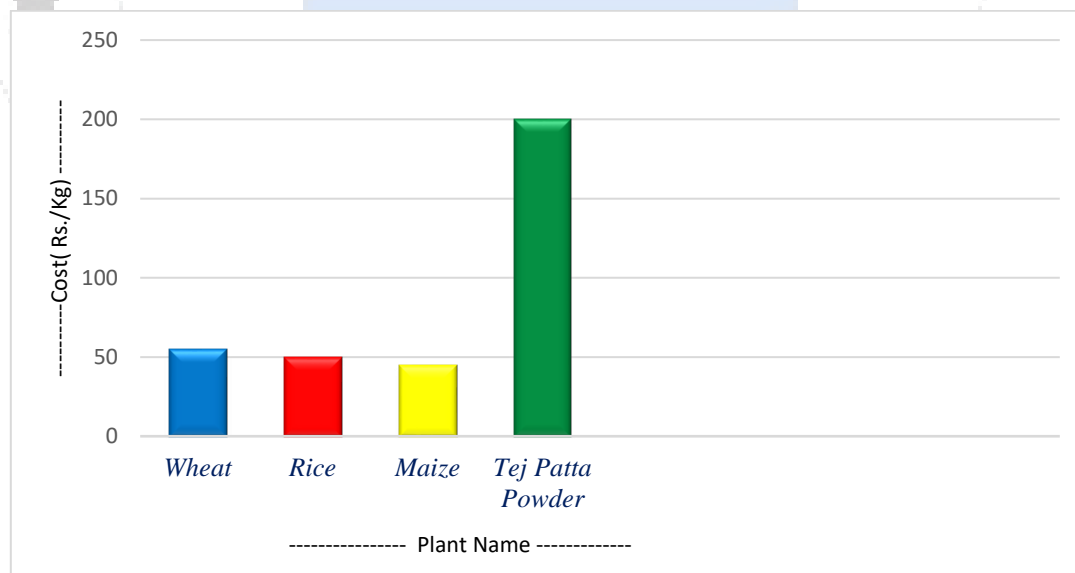


Fig. 4.31 Economic potential of *Cinnamomum tamala* in comparison to conventional crops
