Family: Lauraceae.

Botanical Description:

Evergreen tree: bark in the young stage is smooth and pale; on maturity, it turns brown and brittle; leaves are dark green, ovate, deeply veined, opposite, upper surface shiny; flowers are yellow to white and small; fruits are dark purple, oval, covered by a bell-shaped inflorescence; bark and leaves are aromatic.

Flowering/ Fruiting: January-February/June-August

Part Used: Leaves.

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°43'39" E.

Latitude: 31°27'26" N.

Altitude: 769m.

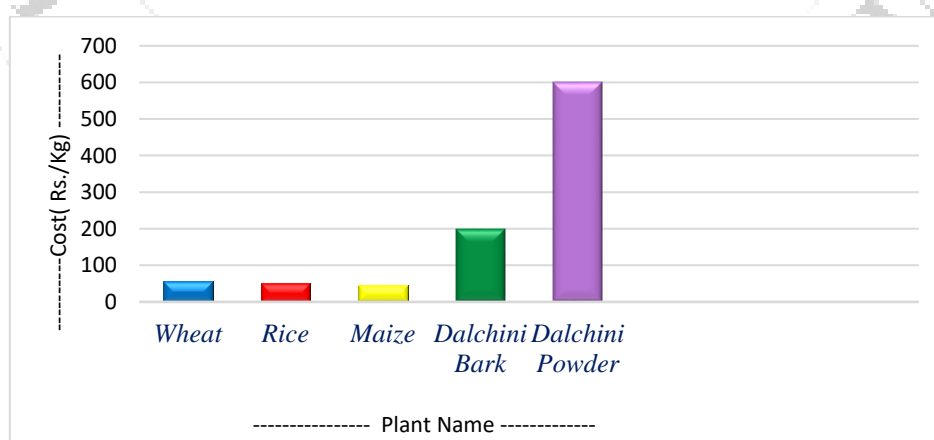


Fig. 4.32 Economic potential of *Cinnamomum zeylanicum* in comparison to conventional crops
