Family: Apiaceae.

Botanical Description:

Annual, aromatic, thin, erect, and small herb, stem is slender, lobed at base, leaves are alternate and compound, lower leaves toothed, and upper leaves linear, inflorescence is umbel type, flowers in small five umbels, white or purplish, fruits are round, stripped, globular, yellow-brownish in colour, when pressed, break into two parts, and fruit has a pleasant fragrance.

Flowering/ Fruiting: January-March/April-May.

Part Used: Stem, leaves, roots

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°36'13"E.

Latitude: 31°39'34"N.

Altitude: 877m.




Fig. 4.35 Economic potential of *Coriandrum sativum* in comparison to conventional crops
