Evergreen perennial, erect, compact, rounded, densely branched, sub shrub, fern-like resemblance, stem slender, brownish, multi-branched, sticky, and glandular fine hairs, leaves simple, dark green, small, glossy, lanceolate to oblong, alternate, shiny, pinnately veined, flowers small, single, purple, trumpet-shaped, in leaf axil, six petals, fruit capsule, seeds are small, numerous, globose, and reddish brown.
