Shrub, bark greyish-brown, fissured, leaves simple, spiral, elliptical, alternate, petiolated, clustered at branch end, leathery texture, narrow, elliptic to lanceolate, flower small, yellow-orange red, axillary or terminal, fruit capsule, with three wings, broad, membranous, compressed, notched, seeds one to two, black in colour.




Fig. 4.39 Economic potential of Dodonea viscosa in comparison to conventional crops
