Botanical Description:

Evergreen, large-branched tree; bark is greyish and rough; leaves are green, simple, shiny, oblong to lanceolate; flowers are white; anthers are linear with fringed petals; fruits are violet in colour, oval, acidic in taste; the seed endocarp is very hard, having 2–5 longitudinal ridges.

Flowering/ Fruiting: April-June.

Part Used: Bark, leaves, fruit, seed. Cultivation: Wild. Longitude: 76°32'08"E. Latitude: 31°31'25"N. Altitude: 898m.




Fig. 4.41 Economic potential of *Elaeocarpus ganitrus* in comparison to conventional crops.
