**Botanical Description:**

Small and erect, annual herb, stem hollow, milky sap from all parts exudes, leaves green, opposite, ovate-elliptic, alternate, margin is entire, long petiolated, inflorescence is cyathium, flowers are green-yellow in colour, occur in clusters at the tip branches, in cup-shaped involucre, fruit is capsule, three-lobed, hairless, having three seeds, seeds brownish to grey in colour, surface is rough.

**Flowering/ Fruiting:** September -March.

**Part Used:** Leaves, roots stem.

**Cultivation:** Wild.
