**Common/Local Name (s):** Dogle, Anjeer, Common Fig.

**Family:** Moraceae.

**Botanical Description:**

Deciduous, medium-size tree, bark is ash-silver grey and smooth, every part exudes milky white latex, leaves are large, single, green, alternate, toothed margin, rough surface, flowers are tiny, inside cup-like structure, fruit is ovoid, unripe green, ripe fruit is dark purple, axillary, solitary, or paired, with a small round opening in the middle of the fruit, seeds are small, minute, numerous, edible.

**Flowering/ Fruiting:** May-June/ July-August.

**Part Used:** Pulp, leaves, roots, and latex

**Cultivation:** Wild.

**Longitude:** 76.3613 E.

**Latitude:** 31.3914 N.

**Altitude:** 878m.

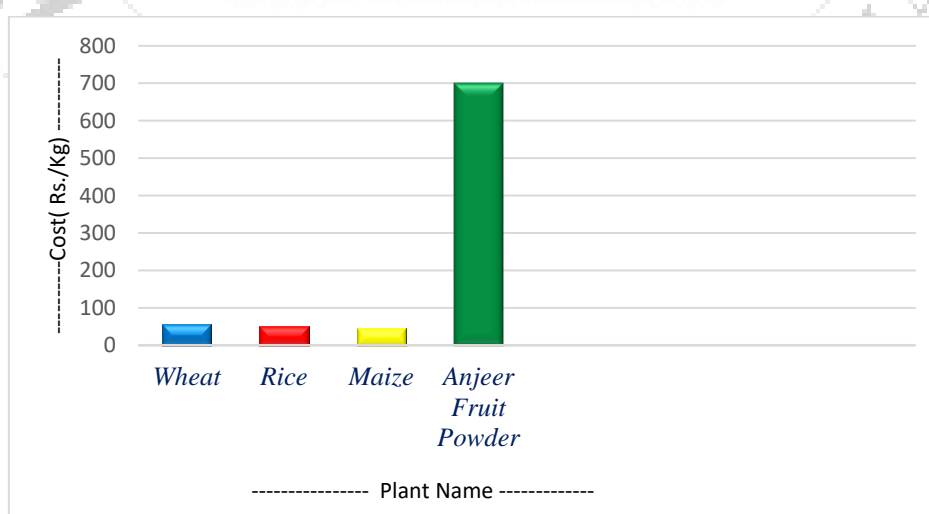


Fig. 4.47 Economic potential of *Ficus carica* in comparison to conventional crops.
