Common/Local Name (s): Gudhal, Gurhal, China Rose, Chini Gulab, Shoe Flower.

Family: Malvaceae.

Botanical Description:

Evergreen, erect, woody shrub, stem solid, cylindrical, green, and branched; leaves are simple, alternate, petiolated, ovate, with reticulate venation; tip is acute; margin toothed; surface glossy; inflorescence is axillary and solitary; flowers may be red, yellow, pink, or orange; fruits are five-valved capsules; seeds are small and endospermic.

Flowering/ Fruiting: July - December.

Part Used: Leaves, young stem, flower and roots.

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°45'57"E.

Latitude: 31°33'30"N.

Altitude: 834m.

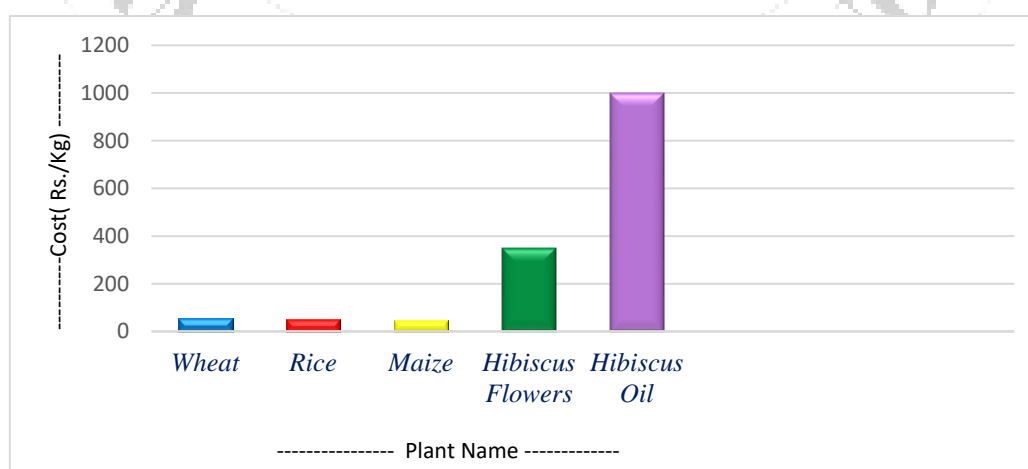


Fig. 4.54 Economic potential of *Hibiscus rosa-sinesis* in comparison to conventional crops
