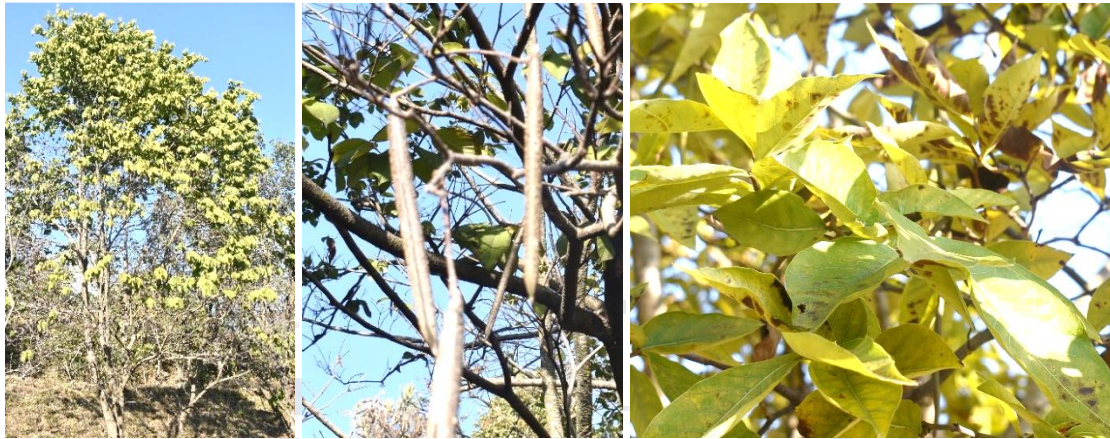

Botanical Description:

Deciduous, medium sized tree, small trunk, wood soft and white, bark grey to brown, rough, bitter in taste, leaves opposite, broad, elliptical – oblong, petiolated, margin is entire, flowers white, mildly scented, fruits dark grey in colour, seeds numerous, brown hairs.

Flowering/ Fruiting: May-June/September-October

Part Used: Bark, seeds.

Cultivation: Wild.

Altitude: 769m

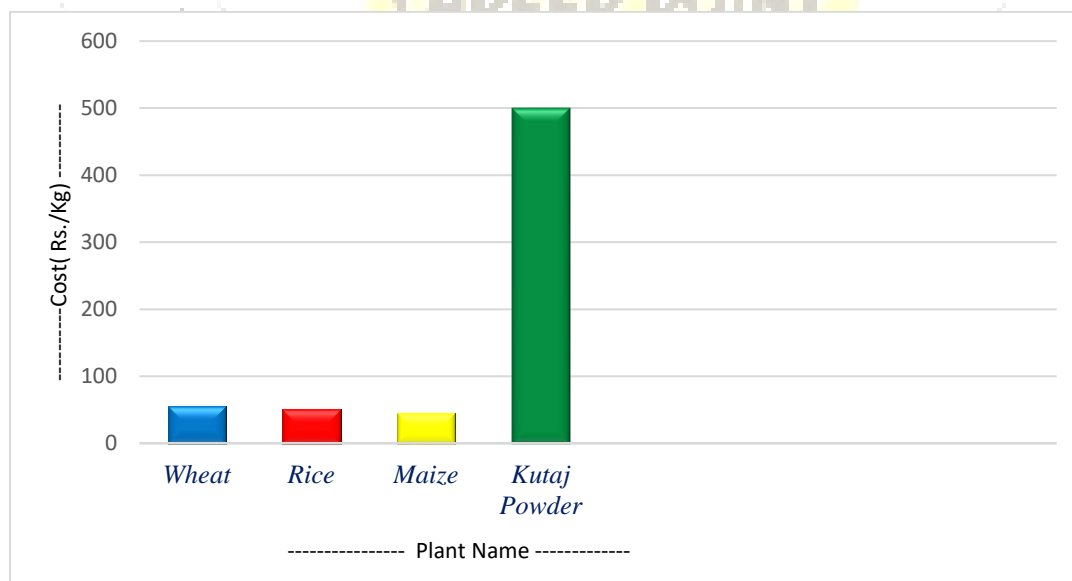


Fig. 4.55 Economic potential of *Holarrhena antidysentrica* in comparison to conventional crops
