Botanical Description:

Erect, perennial, succulent plant; leaves are opposite, thick, fleshy, margin toothed, green to yellowish, elliptical in shape, Inflorescence is terminal and paniculate; pedicels are slender with many pendent flowers; the corolla is tubular; the flowers are bloody in colour; the fruit are large and tubular; the fruit has four slender papery tubes; and the seeds are brownish and oblong.

Flowering/ Fruiting: May-September. Cultivation: Wild. Longitude: 76°36'25"E. Latitude: 31°20'32"N. Altitude: 629m.




Fig. 4.60 Economic potential of Kalanchoe pinnata in comparison to conventional crops
