Evergreen, highly branched tree with a round trunk; bark is dark in colour; leaves are alternate, opposite, long petiolated, with a sharp tip; flowers are small; panicle raceme; fruits are globose, orange-red; 3 lobed capsule; seeds are black, round, and smooth.

Flowering/ Fruiting: October-April.

Part Used: Leaves, roots, hairs of fruit.

Altitude: 821m.




Fig. 4.63 Economic potential of Mallotus philippinensis in comparison to conventional crops
