Family: Meliaceae

Botanical Description:

Deciduous, medium-sized tree, bark grey to brown, leaves pinnate, alternate, petiole is long, compound, leaflets opposite, elliptic to lanceolate, leaf margin toothed, flowers are small and fragrant, fruit is a drupe, green when unripe and light yellow at maturity.

Flowering/ Fruiting: November-January.

Part Used: Bark, leaves, fruit, roots.

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°26'18"E.

Latitude: 31°37'43"N.

Altitude: 760m.

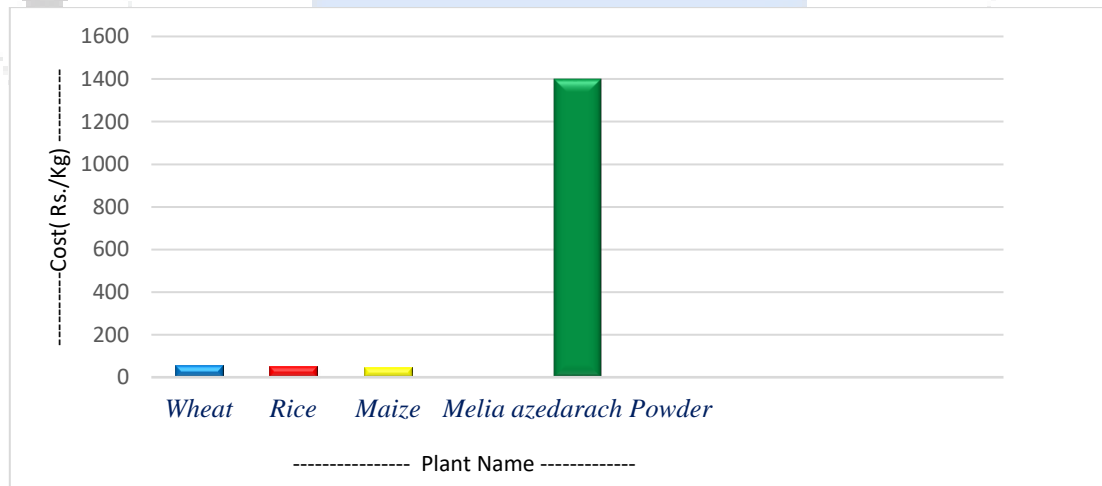


Fig. 4.66 Economic potential of *Melia azedarach* in comparison to conventional crops
