Family: Rutaceae.

Botanical Description:

Deciduous aromatic with pleasant odour shrub, stem is dark green to brownish, dotted, leaves are dark green, compound, lanceolate leaflets, flowers are white, fragrant, 5-lobed, terminal, in clusters, funnel-shaped, fruits are oblong to round in shape, bluish-black, single seed, and the seed is dark green.

Flowering/ Fruiting: April-May/ July-September.

Part Used: Bark, leaves, shoot and fruit.

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°38'22"E.

Latitude: 31°42'06"N.

Altitude: 1052m.

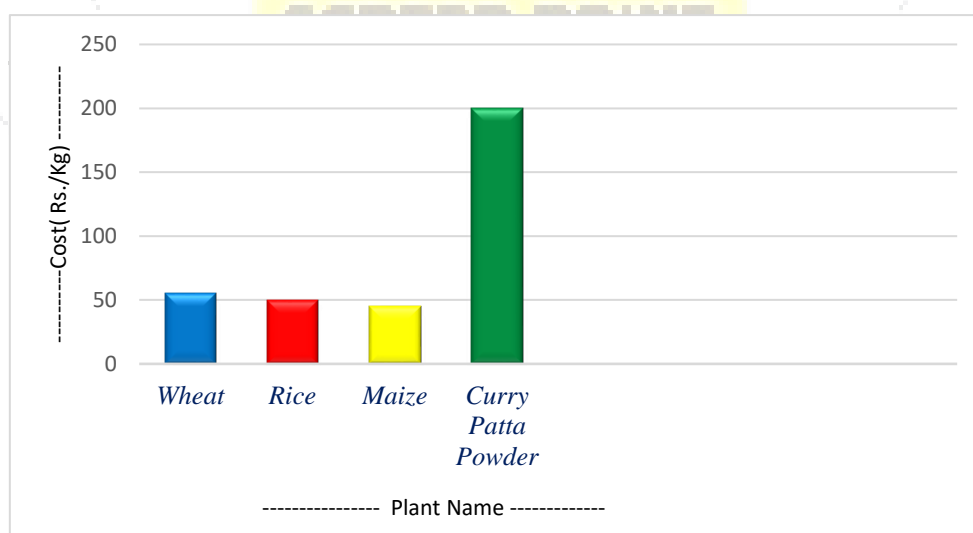


Fig. 4.70 Economic potential of *Murraya koenigii* in comparison to conventional crops
