Common/Local Name (s): Kaner, Lal kaner, kuruvira, oleander.

Family: Apocynaceae.

Botanical Description:

Evergreen, large shrub, milky sap; leaves are narrow at both ends, linear to lanceolate, dark green; midrib prominent; flower color variable from red, pink, to white; funnel-shaped, fragrant; grows in clusters; fruit is a long follicle; seeds are many and have woolly hairs.

Flowering/ Fruiting: April-June.

Part Used: Whole plant.

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°50 '31"E.

Latitude: 31°44 '09"N.

Altitude: 1005m.

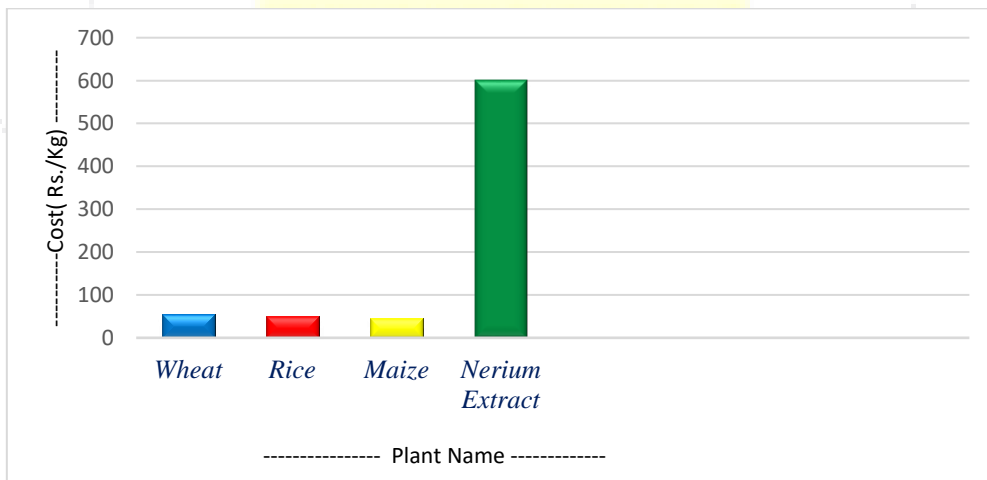


Fig. 4.71 Economic potential of *Nerium indicum* in comparison to conventional crops
