Common/Local Name (s): Tat palanga, Sona-patha, Shyonak, Aralu, Manduk.

Family: Bignoniaceae.

Botanical Description:

Deciduous medium-size tree, night-bloomer so pollinated by bats; bark grey-light brown; large leaves; large petioles; smooth, oblong to elongated; numerous, large flowers; yellowish inside and reddish-purplish on the outer side; strong smell; fruit is a long, flat, and curved pod; seeds are round in shape, flat with papery wings.

Flowering/ Fruiting: June-July/November.

Part Used: Leaves, bark, roots

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°36'01"E.

Latitude: 31°37'43"N.

Altitude: 866m.

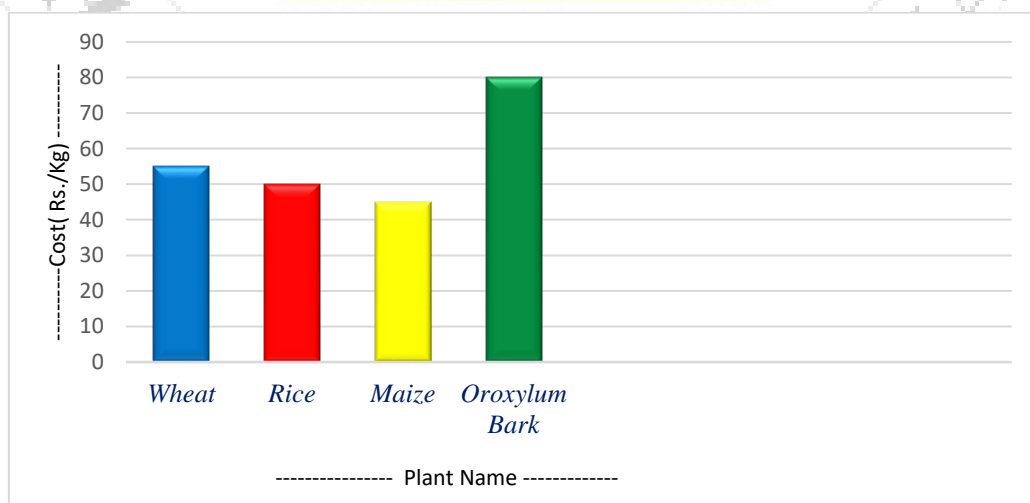


Fig. 4.74 Economic potential of *Oroxylum indicum* in comparison to conventional crops
