Annual herb, stem erect, occurs in watery areas like khad or rivers; leaves are green, alternate, without a stalk; leaves are ovate to lanceolate, narrow, margin entire; leaf base broad and tapering towards the tip; inflorescence is a nodding spike; nodes are prominent; flowers are tinny, greenish-pink; fruit is oval, dark brown; seeds are dark brown to black.
