Flowering/ Fruiting: July-September.

Part Used: Root, leaves, fruits, milky juice, and whole plants.

Cultivation: Wild.

Altitude: 788m.




Fig. 4.75 Economic potential of *Phyllanthus niruri* in comparison to conventional crops
