Deciduous, perennial, large tree; horizontal branches exude milky juice; leaves are large; crown at branchlet ends is shiny, bright green, and glandular; bark is rough, deep furrowed, and has a corky ridge; flowers are small, terminal, yellow-green, and arranged in a terminal spike; they appear when there are no leaves on the plant; Fruit is capsule; three lobed; three seeds; seeds are orbicular.
