Perennial plant, stout stem covered by leaves, leaves are thick, flat, oblong to blunt lanceolate, leaf margin toothed, lower part half stalked, upper part half clasping with blade, flower head covered by boat-shaped papery bracts that are pale yellow in colour, flowers purple dense, cluster, flowers are fragrant but not pleasant.

Flowering/ Fruiting: July-September.

Part Used: Leaves, whole plant.

Cultivation: Wild.
