Botanical Description:

Perennial erect herb, short stem, branches bear recurved thorns, leaves are dark green, alternate, irregularly lobed, petiolate, broad-leaved, long, spines are present on petiole and midrib, bluntly lobed, above surface glossy and lower surface dull, flowers are white, cymes have 3 or 4 flowers, long peduncle, fruit is berry, globose, smooth, round, green when young and turn yellow on maturity, seeds are brown, discoid, and flat.

Flowering/ Fruiting: August-April.

Part Used: Berries, roots.

Cultivation: Wild.

Altitude: 411m.




Fig. 4.86 Economic potential of *Solanum surattense* in comparison to conventional crops
