Medium-sized, perennial evergreen, resinous, and aromatic tree, single or multitrunked, conical to columnar, spreading branches; branchlets are dark green on the upper side while light green to brown on the base; flattened; bark is rusty brown; furrowed; leaves are fanlike, bright green; glossy scale-like; flattened branches; seeds are cone-shaped, slender, yellowgreen to brown.

Altitude: 459m.




Fig. 4.93 Economic potential of *Thuja occidentalis* in comparison to conventional crops
