Annual herb with smooth, erect, or profusely branched stem, smooth, green, circular, exuding juice, leaves are simple, light green, alternate, compound, trifoliate, leaflets are ovate to lanceolate, distinctly petiolate, flowers are borne in leaf axil, lemon yellow when young but turn white in maturity, fruits are smooth, straight, sickle-like pods, having 10-15 seeds, seeds are green to olive or brown, strongly aromatic.




Fig. 4.95 Economic potential of *Trigonella foenum-graceum* in comparison to conventional crops
