Botanical Description:

Perennial, erect, multi-branched bushy plant; stem is woody; bark is thin and grey; leaves have 3-5 leaflets; they are petiolate, lanceolate, acute, palmately compound; margin is entire; inflorescence is long; flowers are bluish-white and aromatic; fruit is round to oval, small, blackish; endocarp is hard; and seeds are oblong, small, and non-endospermic.

Part Used: Flowers, leaves, stem, roots, seed.

Cultivation: Wild.




Fig. 4.99 Economic potential of Vitex negundo in comparison to conventional crops
