Botanical Description:

Perennial, rhizomatous herbaceous plant, stem leafy, upright, underground stem (rhizome) is edible, dull yellow, aromatic, thick, branched, flattened, grow horizontally, covered with small scale leaves, leaves green, narrow, elliptic-oblong, parallel venation, inflorescence form a dense spike, flowers are yellow, green, purple, rarely seen.

Flowering/ Fruiting: September-November.

Part Used: Rhizome, Saunth (Dry Powder).

Cultivation: Wild.

Longitude: 76°36'13"E.

Latitude: 31°39'34"N.

Altitude: 877m.

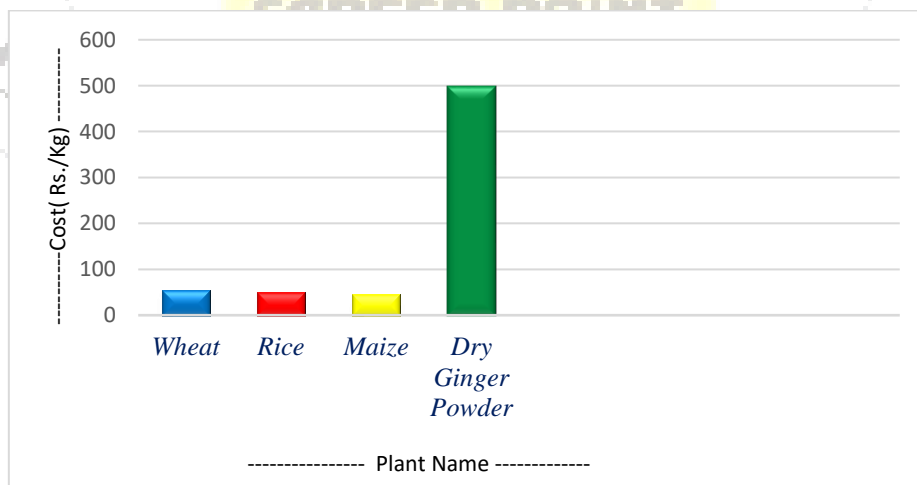


Fig. 4.102 Economic potential of *Zingiber officinale* in comparison to conventional crops
