

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING entered into on 23rd Day of July 2021

Two thousand and twenty one, at Solan between **Sri Badrika Ashram Cum Charitable & Social Welfare Society**, a Society having registered office at Village Shalamu, Post Kargaanu, Distt. Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh- 173223 represented by its Chief Administrator Shri Rajiv Mittal (hereinafter referred to as "**The Society**" which expression shall mean and include, wherever the context so requires or admits, its successors-in-interest, administrators and executors) of the **First Part**.

AND:

The Career Point University, Hamirpur having its campus at Bhoranj, (Tikker- Kharwarian), Hamirpur, 176041, Himachal Pradesh, India (hereinafter referred to as "**The University**" which expression shall mean and include, wherever the context so requires or admits, its successors-in-interest, administrators and executors) of the **Second Part**.

AND WHEREAS the **Sri Badrika Ashram Cum Charitable & Social Welfare Society** is desirous of recording a Memorandum of Understanding with the University, whereas the Society is intended to provide "**Sri Badrika Ashram Emerging Youth Scholarship (पढ़ो और बढ़ो)**" to reward a student's academic achievement and educational progression and help deserving students who want to graduate with their degree and give back to society. Also Society believes and promotes the importance of education and what role it plays in shaping the future of students.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Memorandum of Understanding witnessed as follows:

1. That the **Sri Badrika Ashram Cum Charitable and Social Welfare Society** is desirous of awarding "**Sri Badrika Ashram Emerging Youth Scholarship (पढ़ो और बढ़ो)**" to bright and needy students to support the aspirations of students who hope to build on

their achievements in college and to make significant contributions to society.

2. That the Sri Badrika Ashram Emerging Youth Scholarship (पढ़ो और बढ़ो) provides for tuition fee which may vary from 50 % to 100% of the tuition fee to the maximum of Rs.2.00 lacs or as may be decided by the Society from time to time.

3. That the Sri Badrika Ashram Emerging Youth Scholarship (पढ़ो और बढ़ो) will be provided to the students who are enrolled as student of the University.

4. That the eligibility to receive the award, the candidate must fulfill the following requisites which are as follows:

- a) That the candidate must be enrolled as full time student in any (specific course) undergraduate degree/ diploma in the University.
- b) That the candidate must be a Himachal Pradesh resident holding a Himachal domicile.
- c) That the candidate must be meritorious and scored 60% (For BPL Category) and 75% (For other category) and above in 12th standard to avail the benefit of scholarship of which Xerox documents be submitted signed and attested by the University.
- d) The criteria for selection of student to avail the scholarship shall be one or more of them ;

- i) Students from below poverty line (BPL) families (BPL Card is required)
- ii) Student belonging to a family with an annual income below Rs.3.00 lacs (Income proof such as certificate from tehsildar/SDM is required)
- iii) Single parent households – mother or father are separated, expired
- iv) Families with multiple daughters
- v) Girl student
- vi) Families with cases of chronic/terminal illness in the family such as cancer, etc.
- vii) Background of parents such as those who are engaged in manual jobs, is daily wage labourers, ex-servicemen from the Indian Armed forces.
- viii) A student with merit in previous class – Obtained above 90% marks in preceding degree
- ix) Orphaned students

e) That the candidate must bear good conduct.

f) That the university/college must submit following documents alongwith an application in enclosed jotform:

- i. Aadhar card
- ii. Student identity card
- iii. Mark sheets of previous semesters in case of 2nd year onwards
- iv. Family Income proof/BPL Card
- v. Any other document required by the Society

g) That the candidate must belong to BPL family.

5. That to continue to receive the award from 2nd year onward the university/college will be required to submit the following documents;

- i. Certificate that the candidate has maintained 75% or above attendance during the preceding semesters of year.
- ii. Marksheet for the previous year semesters showing minimum of 75% marks
- iii. Undertaking that the student is not getting scholarship from any other private or government organization
- iv. Undertaking that the student bears good conduct and behavior.

5. That the scholarship amount shall be transferred to the University's designated account directly.

6. That the Scholarship is non transferable.

5. That it is agreed between the parties that the University will recognize and appreciate the Donor and make appropriate announcements through internal and external publications and to the media. It shall be the responsibility of the University to make appropriate measures to announce the presence of **Sri Badrika Ashram Emerging Youth Scholarship (पढ़ो और बढ़ो)** in University Brochure and on University website and also acknowledge the Contribution made by the Society in various print and electronic media and also to give recognition in the Annual Report published by the University.

6. That the University / college has authorized Mr Subhash Sharma, Section Officer, office of the Registrar, Mob. No.8894718242 and Mr Rajesh Bhardwaj, Clerk, Office of the Associate Dean Students Welfare, Mob. No. 7018640749 to be the main contact persons for all correspondence and handling of this scholarship scheme.

7. That the University will send the profiles of eligible candidates after Verification to the

Society and the Society reserves its right to decide

- 8. Candidates to be awarded with the Scholarship and decision will be final and will be informed to the University.
- 9. That the Society reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship of any student or all of them at any time and the University has no recourse to bind the Society in any manner.
- 10. That the Scholarships shall be awarded to the students in successive years until graduation provided the recipient maintains eligibility.
- 11. That the MOU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of 5(five) years. It shall automatically be renewed for next 2 years until & unless discontinued by either party.
- 12. That the Sri Badrika Ashram Cum Charitable and Social Welfare Society has the sole authority to terminate the MOU and same shall be communicated to the University six months in advance.
- 13. That all notices or other communications under or in connection with this MOU shall be given in writing and shall be deemed to be sufficiently given if they are forwarded by registered post A.D./ hand delivery with acknowledgment to the Chief Administrator, Shri Rajiv Mittal.


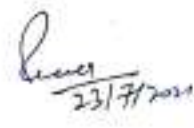

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MoU

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Agreement for Utilization of Funds under the Chief Minister's Startup/ Innovation Projects/ New Industries Scheme* for Providing Support for Entrepreneurial and Managerial Development of SMEs through Incubators.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement has made and entered into this Friday, 27th day of September, 2019 between the Governor of the State represented by Sh. Hans Raj Sharma, Director of Industries Himachal Pradesh, (hereinafter referred to as 'The First Party' which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successor in interest and permitted assigns) of the one part.

And

Name of authorized signatory Dr S Valbhav, Associate Dean (Engineering and Technology) for the (Host Institution HI) and its legal status, having its registered office at Career Point University, Hamirpur (hereinafter referred to as 'The Second Party' which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successor in interest and permitted assigns) of the one part.

Whereas, the Government wishes to assist the Empanelled Incubator/ Host Institution (HI) to set up Incubator for establishing ecosystems for Innovation Projects/ Start-ups to help the entrepreneurial venture to succeed, and whereas, the HI is willing to perform this assignment. Now, therefore, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1.0 PREAMBLE

1.1 In order to support and promote untapped creativity of the individual innovators, Government has formulated a scheme for providing support for Startups/ Entrepreneurial and Managerial Development of Small and Medium Enterprises through incubators. The scheme envisages forging linkages of innovators and entrepreneurs with important constituents of the innovation chain, viz., research/ academic Institutes and Incubators, so as to leverage the available

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know-how, expertise, facilities and infrastructure in such institutions to help the entrepreneurial ventures to succeed.

- 12 It has been agreed by the Government to support PIONEER - (Name of the existing/ New Incubator) located at Tikkar-Kharwardan, Tehsil Bhoran, Distt. Hamirpur(HP) and hosted by Career Point University, Hamirpur (HP) (name of the Host Institution) based on a request made by the Host second party has also agreed to abide by the terms, conditions & the operational guidelines of the scheme.

20 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HOST INSTITUTE

- 21 The Host Institute shall undertake business incubation and entrepreneurship development activities as per the provisions of Startup Policy and guidelines and execute obligations under the proposed Scheme and guidelines. The entity is referred henceforth as the Empanelled Incubator.

22 The activities of the Empanelled Incubator shall include:

- 22.1 Nucleation of new business ideas by creating the environment and opportunities for know-how providers, entrepreneurs and financiers to meet each other and from business teams;
- 22.2 Nurturing businesses in their startup phase by creating and running an efficient Empanelled Incubator offering not only space but also access to technology support, business mentoring, networks, scientific and information resources, and a generally conducive and supportive environment; and
- 22.3 Promoting and running an active program for identification, creation and translation (into practical) of business ideas suitable for new venture creation.
- 22.4
- (i) The incubator shall nurture new ideas/ new Industries to support them in their entire life cycle till the same is turned into a commercial enterprise. The incubator shall also establish tie up with appropriate industries so that new ideas/ New Industries get nurtured in an appropriate environment.
 - (ii) The incubator shall act as a hub with other academic institutes in the district acting as spokes driving the innovation ecosystem in the geography. They shall be mandated to incubate projects through competitive selection process among students, alumni as well as local entrepreneurs. Students of such institutions will also be encouraged to intern with startup incubators recognized by the state government to do their mini-projects or summer/ winter projects or Internships that are done during vacations. The incubators may be mandated to run selection programs throughout the state to ensure that students have access from any collage in Himachal Pradesh. Such projects can then also be converted to final year Projects where the academic Institutes/University and college must involve an external project guide/ mentor as identified by such incubators.
 - (iii) Establishing Support Eco-Systems, Capital Asset Management and Resources as required for the Incubator.
 - (iv) Liaison with Angel and Venture Capital investors to provide funding assistance to the incubated startups.
 - (v) Shortfalls if any in revenue generation will be met by Private Partner, post the support period.

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- (vi) Ensure pro-active participation of other Private Sector companies for the Incubator in terms of raising funds for incubator and angel investment for start-ups.
- (vii) Empanelled Incubator must adhere to all provisions of Startup Scheme and guidelines throughout its association with State Government.

- 23 The Host Institute shall provide ready-to-use, dedicated space for housing and operation of the Empanelled Incubator.
- 24 The Host Institute shall be responsible for providing access to basic infrastructural facilities, office facilities and laboratory/ facilities for the Empanelled Incubator.
- 25 The Host Institute shall be responsible for providing access the resources arranging the resources for the day-to-day operation of the Empanelled Incubator.
- 26 The operation of the Empanelled Incubator shall be governed by the Screening Committee as given under which will be constituted with the approval of the Board of Governors (BOG) of the Host Institutions and comprise of at least the following:
 - 2.6.1 Executive Head of the EMPANELLED INCUBATOR (Ex-officio Chairperson).
 - 2.6.2 One representative of the Government of HP's promoter agency, in present case representative of Directorate of Industries (Member).
 - 2.6.3 One representative of the industry/ industry association (Member).
 - 2.6.4 One representative of the financial institutions (Member).
 - 2.6.5 One representative from the academic community of the Host Institution (Member).
 - 2.6.6 One R&D expert (Member).
 - 2.6.7 Empanelled Incubator Manager (Member-Secretary).
- 27 The Empanelled Incubator shall be run by dedicated staff and shall also utilize the service of faculty/ staff of the Host Institute or expert from outside.

3 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHEME AND FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 The Empanelled Incubator/ Screening Committee shall be responsible for arranging/ mobilizing all applicable funds from the State and publicizing the scheme and seeking proposals under the scheme in the approved format and meeting the performance standards mentioned below and as per Startup Scheme and guidelines:
 - a. Empanelled incubator must train at least 10 incubatees in the first year and 10 incubatees in the subsequent years, provide handholding support till their venture is commercialized and/ or two years from date of approval. At least 10% of the incubatees must reach the next stage of development each year i.e. from idea to Prototype or from Prototype to successful testing or from testing to market launch (stage should be certified by CII/ Startup Cell).
 - b. Empanelled incubator from its third year of operation must achieve funding from HP Venture Capital Fund or Private funds or Debt financing from Banks or Angel Investor for at least one incubatee each year.
 - c. Apart from the above criteria, Incubators will be given a score by the Himachal Pradesh Startup Cell based on biannual reviews of the partner incubator's performance.
 - d. The Empanelled Incubator will be required to submit half yearly reports as per prescribed format, if it is found that the Empanelled Incubator is not rendering the services as per the provisions of Startup Policy and guidelines to the satisfaction of the Himachal Pradesh Startup Cell/ HPCED, the Cell may/ shall initiate appropriate action against the Empanelled Incubator and seek EC approval in this regard.

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- 32 The incubator shall ensure that the selection of entrepreneur/ incubatee is fair and the disbursement, Utilization of the fund is done with fairness to the entrepreneurs/ incubatee.
- 33 The incubator shall ensure that the fund requested for one idea in the proposal does not exceed the specified limit.
- 34 The funds shall be released by the HP Government according to the following schedule:

- 35 The Host Institution/ Empanelled Incubator shall maintain separate accounts of the funds received and expenditure incurred on various activities. Further, the EI would submit Annual Accounts, Audited expenditure statement and Utilization certificate to the Government.

4.0 GENERAL

- 4.1 The Host Institution (HI)/ Empanelled Incubators (EI) shall submit the agreement made by them and with Incubatee to the Government before release of funds to the HI/ EI for utilization by the incubatee.
- 4.2 The assets created through the scheme shall not be transferred/ disposed off without prior permission of the Office of the Government.
- 4.3 In the event it is found that HI/ EI has not utilized amount of grant, or any part of it, for the purpose agreed to in agreement or has subsequently disposed off any of the assets acquired out of the grant without prior permission of the Empowered Committee, the Empowered Committee without prejudice to any other right, shall be entitled to terminate this agreement and liable to recover the grant with penal interest @ 15% of the total grant released.

5.0 DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 5.1 Any disputes shall be settled amicably between parties through the intervention and assistance of the Executive Head of the Empanelled Incubator. If the dispute is not resolved, then the matter may be escalated to the attention of the Executive Head of the Host Institute. If the dispute is still not resolved then the matter be referred to the Principal Secretary Industries whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT [MOA]

Between
GRAM SUDHAR SABHA, TIKKER
&
CAREER POINT UNIVERSITY, HAMIRPUR

Sharing a common desire to rejuvenate, restore and revive traditional drinking water sources/water bodies (*Bawdi, Khattris etc.*) with local community participation the Gram Sudhar Sabha hereinafter called First Party, and the Career Point University (CPU) Hamirpur, Tehsil Bhoranj, District Hamirpur, Himachal Pradesh herewith sign the Memorandum of Agreement which reads as under:

1. Both the parties shall work in close harmony and with active participation of local community members for the rejuvenation, restoration and revival of the traditional drinking water sources including *Bawdis, Khattris* etc. in and around the village Tikker.
2. First party shall generate funding and required resources through the various schemes of local panchayat administration from the state and central government schemes for rejuvenation, restoration and revival of traditional water sources.
3. Second party shall apply and generate funding from the various government and non government agencies for rejuvenation, restoration and revival of traditional water sources.
4. Construct water storage tanks to store the drinking water. The stored water shall be lifted to a reserve tank at higher elevation and then siphoned to each household of the village free of cost.
5. The stored water shall be used by the Career Point University for its daily use on the mutual agreed rates per month.
6. The members of First Party and Scientists/faculty of second party will be included as resource persons for delivering lectures on rejuvenation, restoration and revival of traditional water sources for local use.
7. There will be a Steering Committee comprising of 4 members two from each Party. The said committee will look after all the Proposals/Cases pertaining to Memorandum of Agreement.
8. The above MoA will be effective for a period of 5 years from the date of its signing by both the parties. The MoA shall be periodically reviewed in a joint meeting to assess the progress and also to identify new areas for collaboration. In case of dispute if any, it will be decided by the Head of Institution and Chairman of Gram Sudhar Sabha.

9. The MoA reflects the respective party's commitment as per the mutual agreed terms & conditions.
10. This MoA shall be amended by holding joint meeting of the representatives nominated by the First party and Second party.
11. The agreement can be terminated by the either of the party by giving three months notice. However, the MoA and corresponding programme arrangements shall continue for ongoing activities until completion of the work to a maximum period of one year from the date of termination.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** entered into on 30th day of January, 2023 at Hamirpur, Himachal Pradesh.

BETWEEN

Career Point University Hamirpur (HP) is a State Private University established in the year 2012 by the Government of Himachal Pradesh vide Act no. 12/2012 under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act 1956, having its campus at Bhoranj, Hamirpur (Himachal Pradesh)- 176041, (Hereinafter referred to as "**CPU**", which expression, unless otherwise provided, shall mean and include its successors- in -interest, administrators and executors) through the Head of Institution **Dr. Sanjeev Sharma, Vice Chancellor of the FIRST PARTY.-**

And

Himalyan Mahila Avam Jan Kalyan Sanstha, is a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO)/Voluntary Organization (VO)/Non-Profit Organization (NPO) that operates independently of any government, typically one whose purpose is to address a social or political issue having its registered Office at Mini Secretariat, Bassi, Tehsil-Bhoranj, District Hamirpur, H.P-176045 (Hereinafter referred to as "**HMAJKS**", which expression, unless repugnant to the context thereof, shall mean and include its successors- in -interest, administrators and executors) through its duly authorized representative, **Mrs. Anjana Thakur, Founder Chairperson of the SECOND PARTY.**

WHEREAS both the parties jointly herein shall be referred to as the Parties and individually as Party.

WHEREAS CPU and HMAJKS realize that in the current context, working together is important to promote Spiritual Psychology, Yoga Sciences, Traditional Medicine and Philosophy using facilities and expertise at both the organizations. Therefore, both parties mutually agree to cooperate on student engagement programs and community development initiatives based on the principles of common interest and reciprocity.

OBJECTIVES

Both the Institutions of CPU and HMAJKS hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through research and study especially in the fields of Health Care, Physical, Psychological Wellbeing, Diet & Nutrition, Life Sciences and Social Sciences in furtherance of the following objectives:

1. To promote inter disciplinary academic and social activities and skill enhancement and community development etc.
2. To promote institutional and individual contacts among scholars, students and personnel of both the institutions as well as among masses of adjoining villages.
3. To provide opportunities for both faculty, scientists, staff and associates to make optimal use of the expertise and facilities available in both the organizations through training of faculty/students/staff/villagers/communities and through exchange of thoughts and ideas by brain storming sessions/ workshops/ seminars/ conferences/ meetings/awareness programs and drives of national level etc.
4. To initiate interdisciplinary researches in Yoga, Psychology, Physiology, Genetics, communities while addressing the common interest and wellbeing of community people etc.
5. To work jointly for the common research interest at national and international levels. This includes preparation of proposals and their implementation as per the National Health Priorities.
6. To support the exchange of academic, research and training material.
7. To share experiences, expertise and best practices concerning institutional administration and management.
8. To encourage any other activities that both the institutions agreed upon for mutual benefits.
9. To depute Yoga Instructors/ Yoga Trainer and other Managerial facility for the Awareness/Training/Wellness programs for HMAJKS. The HMAJKS will provide the remuneration/honorarium etc. to the Yoga Instructors as per the approved rates of Govt. of India/ MDNIY if needed.

10. CPU will provide technical support to run the Yoga training/programs and other therapy/traditional Medicine programs at HMAJKS.

Financial Obligation

1. Financial implication for engagement of manpower or research staff and faculty shall be decided mutually on sharing basis. This would be subject to financial approval by the competent authority if any required.
2. The fees to be charged to conduct any courses under the center and engagement of manpower shall be decided mutually.

DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This MoU shall be in force for five years from date of signing and is subject to revision / modification by mutual written consent by giving one month notice.
2. This MoU may be terminated by either party by giving a written notice of termination at least three months prior to the desired termination date. However, both parties may agree that all continuing obligations to students, staff, funding bodies or other entities are met in full subsequent to the notice of termination.
3. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the rights or obligations of either party regarding any binding offer or firm obligation mutually approved prior to the notice of termination or termination date whichever is applicable.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

4. In event of any dispute/s arising between the parties hereto, it shall be endeavor of both the parties to first make an attempt to resolve the dispute amicably by mutual discussion and deliberation, failing which the dispute shall be referred to Arbitration. The Arbitration shall be conducted as per the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and amendments thereto. The Arbitral Tribunal shall consist of a sole Arbitrator, to be appointed mutually by both the parties. The seat of Arbitral tribunal shall be Hamirpur only. The language of Arbitration shall be English. The Award of the Tribunal shall be final and binding on the both parties.

1. If any provision of this Memorandum is held illegal, void or unenforceable in whole or in part, by any court or other competent authority, this Memorandum shall continue to be valid as to the other provisions thereof and for the remaining period.
2. Nothing in this MoU construes a party as the partner, agent, employee or representative of the other party. A party must not act independently of the other Party and does not have the right or power to commit the other Party on any matter or incur any obligation on behalf of or pledge the credit of the other Party without the prior written approval of the other Party.
3. The parties agree to comply with all laws applicable within the jurisdiction of the signatories below.
