Rules of the Elections to Students Bar Council Elections

The rules for the elections to Students Bar Council areas under:

1. Nomination Process: Eligibility: All students enrolled in the Law department are eligible to nominate themselves or other eligible candidates.

Nominations should be submitted to Dikshit Soni BALLB Ix semester by 24.08.2023. Nominations received after this deadline will not be considered.

Qualifications for students running in Bar Council Elections:

- **1.** Must be a registered active undergraduate student.
- 2. Minimum CGPA of 7.5.
- 3. Should not have appeared for a re-major in any preceding semester.

- 4. Must not have been detained or debarred from major exams.
- 5. Should not have received any punishment or disciplinary warning from the university.
- 6. Must not have been involved in any incidents of ragging.
- 7. No FIR should be registered against the candidate.
- **2. Campaign Period:** The campaign period will conclude on 26.08.2023. Candidates are encouraged to engage in fair and respectful campaigning within the defined guidelines of the university.
- **3. Voting Process:** The voting will take place on 28.08.2023 from 10:00 to 02:00 P.M. All eligible students will have the opportunity to cast their votes in a designated area within the university premises.
- **4. Counting of Votes:** The counting of votes will be conducted immediately after the voting concludes on 28.08.2023 03:00 P.M. Results will be announced on 28.08.2023 03:20 P.M. and displayed on the official notice board.
- **5.** Code of Conduct: All candidates and students are expected to maintain a high standard of ethical behavior and adhere to the university's code of conduct throughout the election process.




